






## Reception - Spring 2

<p><b>Science</b></p> 	<p><b>To be completed during the week beginning 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2025</b></p> <p>Can you plant a seed at home? Can you observe it over time? What does it need to help it grow? Write some of your observations down. Write a list of instructions on how to plant a seed.</p>
<p><b>Technology</b></p> 	<p><b>To be completed during the week beginning 10<sup>th</sup> March 2025</b></p> <p>Have a look around your home. How many different types of technology can you find? Which room has the most electrical devices? Talk to your grown-up and find out what they are all used for.</p>
<p><b>Engineering</b></p> 	<p><b>To be completed during the week beginning 17<sup>th</sup> March 2025</b></p> <p>Read the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff (also found on YouTube). Can you design a bridge that can hold all three Billy Goats (3 toys) for 30 seconds without it collapsing? What is making the Troll grumpy in the story? How can you design your bridge to help? Talk about your ideas with your grown-up, design it and then finally make your bridge.</p>
<p><b>Arts</b></p> 	<p><b>To be completed during the week beginning 24<sup>th</sup> March 2025</b></p> <p>Can you find different objects to print with around your house or garden? What sort of print do they make on paper? You could use potatoes, leaves, stamps etc. Can you use these prints to create a masterpiece? For example, you could use bubble wrap to print the scales on a snake!</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p> 	<p><b>To be completed during the week beginning 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025</b></p> <p>Have a go at spotting some 3D shapes in your home environment.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• What do you notice about the shape?</li> <li>• Can you spot any shapes that are the same? Can you spot any that are different?</li> <li>• How do you know they are the same/different?</li> <li>• How can you sort the shapes?</li> </ul>
