Year 3 – Summer 2

Science



To be completed during the week beginning 9th June 2025

In our Science lessons, we will be learning about forces. Find a small object from around your house that will roll (e.g. ball, toy car). Have a go at rolling it on different surfaces (e.g. hard floor, carpet, grass, stones, cardboard). Conduct an experiment to see which surface allows your object to roll the furthest. What do you need to keep the same to make your experiment fair? Which forces are used in this experiment?

Technology



To be completed during the week beginning 16th June 2025

Choose a European country. With adult support, use the Internet to research that country and make a fact file about it. Questions you might use include: What is the capital city? What is the culture like? What language do they speak? How many people live there?

Engineering



To be completed during the week beginning 23rd June 2025

Create a minibeast hotel for you garden or local park. How will you create small, safe places

for minibeasts to hide in?







Arts



To completed during the week beginning 30th June 2025

Create a scenic landscape drawing or painting of your favourite natural area. It could be of your garden, or somewhere locally that you have walked e.g. Willen Lake or Howe Park.

Maths







To be completed during the week beginning 7th July 2025

In Maths lessons, we will be learning about Statistics. Ask your family and friends to answer the question: what is your favourite fruit? Record the answers in a tally chart and use the data to create a pictogram or a bar chart.
