







Year 1 - Spring 1

<p>Science</p> 	<p>To be completed during the week beginning 12th January 2026</p> <p>The Human Body - Can the children draw a body outline then label it with the body part names they know? Can they name body parts we can see and ones we can't like the brain or the heart?</p> <p>You could even have a go at an action song like Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes or Simon Says with different body parts!</p>
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>To be completed during the week beginning 19th January 2026</p> <p>Use the internet to research Formula 1 at Silverstone. What is the British Grand prix? When did motor cars start racing at Silverstone? How are old racing cars different to racing cars now? Can you use the information you have found to create a fact file on Silverstone, The British Grand Prix or on racing cars through the ages?</p>
<p>Engineering</p> 	<p>To be completed during the week beginning 26th January 2026</p> <p>Research and build your own paper aeroplane. How many different designs can you make? Once you have created your aircrafts you should practice flying them. Which one travels the furthest? Why do you think this is? Use a tool to measure how far they travel - this could be a ruler, tape measure or a piece of string.</p>
<p>Arts</p> 	<p>To be completed during the week beginning 2nd February 2026</p> <p>Design a mermaid or a dragon! When drawing their mythical creature can they think about the shapes they need to use, the pattern on the dragon's skin or the mermaid's tail, and the colours that would suit their character?</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>To be completed during the week beginning 9th February 2026</p> <p>Create your own snakes and ladders board game! Use a number grid up to 20 and practice playing with a friend/family. Discuss the value of the numbers and whether a number is more or less than another number. You will need:</p> <p>Paper, scissors, ruler, pencil, colouring pencils and a dice. Cut out 2 coloured circles for counters.</p>
