


Year 2 - Spring 2

<p>Science</p> 	<p>This week your science mission is to become a plant scientist! Your job is to study how a plant changes over time and record what you discover. You can choose a plant in your garden, a pot plant, or even plant your own seed and watch it grow.</p>
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>This week your homework is to become a digital designer! You will need to use Word, PowerPoint or another computer program (Google Docs/Slides, Paint etc) to create a bright, eye-catching poster that teaches people about helping the planet. You must explain the importance of saving electricity and recycling.</p>
<p>Engineering</p> 	<p>This week, your challenge is to become a real engineer and designer! You will draw a labelled design of a car you would like to create, then try to build a model of your design using materials you can find at home. Try to include extra details to make it exciting, such as wheels, windows, lights, seats, engine area, decorations or colours, special features.</p>
<p>Arts</p> 	<p>This week, your challenge is to become a dancer, choreographer, and teacher! You will create your very own one-minute dance routine to your favourite song and teach it to a friend or family member. Choose your song, create a dance routine, practise your dance, teach someone else and if you want to record your routine.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>This week your challenge is to use a measurement skills to find out how tall you and your family members are. You will measure, compare, and then explain who is the tallest and shortest. You will need: a tape measure or ruler, a pencil, paper to record your measurements, an adult helper for accuracy.</p>
