


Year 1 - Spring 2

<p>Science</p> 	<p>Carry out a fun Five Senses Hunt around your home or garden. Make a simple chart with 5 boxes (see, hear, smell, touch, taste). Find:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 things you can see • 2 things you can hear • 2 things you can smell • 3 things you can touch • 1 thing you can taste (safe food only!)
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>Use a device at home (laptop/tablet/phone) and open a simple writing app (Word, Notes, Google Docs, etc.). Task: Write three sentences about something you enjoy (e.g., a toy, a pet, a family activity). Change the font, size, and colour of at least one word. Add a full stop or question mark to each sentence.</p>
<p>Engineering</p> 	<p>Use toilet-roll tubes, cardboard strips or kitchen-roll segments to create a tube and connector Caterpillar Challenge: How can you join each segment? (string, tape, split pins, straws) Can you create a caterpillar that bends or moves?</p>
<p>Arts</p> 	<p>Create your own animal using paint, drawing or construction materials</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Choose 5 objects at home and line them up from shortest to longest. Use a non-standard unit (Lego brick, pasta piece, paperclip) to measure each one. Record:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The object - How many units long it is <p>Extra challenge: Predict which object is longest before measuring. Were you right?</p>
